PRESIDENT’S COMMENTS:

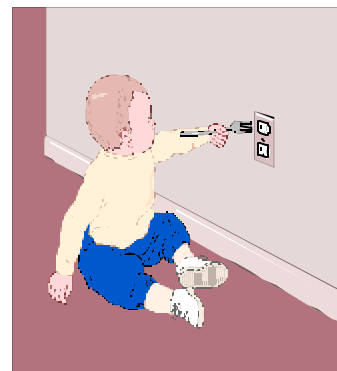
I want to remind everyone that September is Baby Safety Month, so try to bring safety items with you to the meeting so we can make a donation to the Family Support Center.
