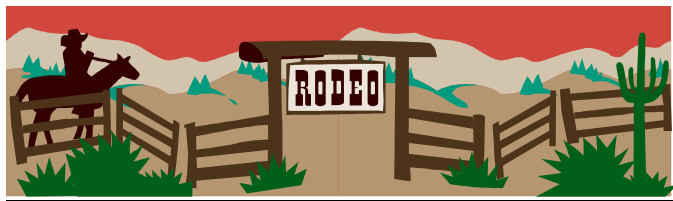
We were then dismissed with our motto, Unity for Service.
